Discussion with Holocaust Survivor Linda Marshak moderated by Lillian Rappaport

Linda (Capp) Marshak was born on the eve of World War II in Ostrog, Poland to a large, successful and close-knit Jewish family. With the arrival of the Nazis, however, her family, her town and the whole Jewish world she was born into was wiped out. With ultimate courage and grit and with the help of good samaritans and good fortune, Linda and her mother managed to escape, and ultimately emmigrated to the United States in 1948. Linda lost her family of origin, but today has a thriving Jewish family including her granddaughter, Rabbi Ariana Capptauber. Linda taught Judaics at a Day School in New York, and has shared her story of survival with audiences in public schools, Jewish day schools and Universities.
